Registration Procedure

Join Our Community

- Parents of a new applicant contact the school to set an appointment with the vice principal.
- The vice principal interviews the parents to inquire about the applicant's academic, social, and behavioral background and to introduce the school's philosophy, student body, staff, physical plant, and curricula.
- Parents fill a pre-registration form during the interview and agree with the vice principal on a date for the placement test.
- The Preschool section conducts the placement test for the Preschool applicants.
- Applicants to the Elementary School, Middle School and Senior School sections (Lebanese, American, and IBDP programs) sit for a placement test in specific subjects.
- The results of the placement test are evaluated in light of the applicant's school references and previous grades.
- The parents are informed of the admission decision, recommendations, and conditions.
 - N.B.: An applicant is not accepted if the school cannot cater for his/her needs.
- Parents complete the student application form in order to proceed with the official registration.
