SPORTS DAY-IMPORTANT POINTS

Please take note of the following important points that will ensure the safety of our students and aid us in making the Sports Day a success:

- Students <u>not enrolled in the school bus service</u> must be **dropped off** at **Beirut Sports Arena-Jnah** at **9:00am** and **picked up** from **Beirut Sports Arena-Jnah** promptly at **1:15pm**.
 - NOTE: Preschool, Grade 1 and Grade 2 students should be picked up from school at 12:30pm.
- Students <u>enrolled in the school bus service</u> will be picked up in the morning a little bit later than usual from their homes and dropped back home after the event is over. The school will inform the students beforehand about the time at which they will be picked up and dropped off.
- Students must wear the cap and colored T-shirt distributed to them at school and comfortable sports pants or sports shorts. They should also apply sunscreen before coming to the arena.
- Parents/Guardians must inform the school nurse and heads of sections ahead of time of food allergies and/or health problems their children/wards might have.
- All school rules apply on the day and all cell phones must be handed to the supervisor at the gate of the sports arena.
