TERM EXAM RULES FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL AND SENIOR SCHOOL LEARNERS

- Students must wear their school uniform on all exam days.
- Students have to come prepared with the necessary items, like pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, sharpeners, calculators ... The school is not responsible for providing students with any of these items.
- Students need to be present in school 15 minutes before their exams start. Once in school, students cannot leave school unless they are done with their exams for that day.
- Students will be allowed to leave when they are done with their exams, unless advised otherwise by the parents/guardians.
- Students enrolled in the school bus service need a written permission from their parents/guardians to leave prior to the bus time.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform can be purchased on Tuesdays and Thursdays only. Kindly place your order at the reception in the morning then collect it in the afternoon.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- For the safety and security of our students, visitors to LWIS-CiS will only be allowed to school if they have a pre-arranged appointment. Visitors who do not have an appointment will have to wait at the gate to arrange for clearance. This could take time and, possibly, they will be denied entrance. Hence, if you wish to visit the school or wish to talk to teachers or administrators, make an appointment to avoid delay or disappointment.
- At the end of the day, the school gates will be closed until all school buses depart. Only parents/guardians of Preschool students will be allowed into the school after the departure of the buses. No other parent/guardian will be allowed in unless he/she has a clearance from the administration.
