SAFETY AND SECURITY

- For the safety and security of our students, visitors to LWIS-CiS will only be allowed to school if they have a pre-arranged appointment. Hence, if you wish to visit the school or wish to talk to teachers or administrators, make an appointment to avoid delay or disappointment.
